## MTR Student Travel Scheme 2023/24

To enjoy concessionary MTR fares, you are required to use a Personalised Octopus with valid "Student Status".

#### **Eligibility**

The applicant must be a student conforming to the following definitions:

"Student" - any person aged between 12 and 25 who is currently enrolled on a full-time day course offered by an eligible institution in Hong Kong.

"Full-time day course" - a day-time course which normally requires the participant to attend an eligible local institution not less than 20 hours of academic instruction each week for 30 weeks or more in an academic year.

## **Application Procedures**

New Applications (with or without Personalised Octopus) or renewal applications can now be submitted via MTR mobile app or MTR website at <a href="https://studenteapplication.mtr.com.hk/">https://studenteapplication.mtr.com.hk/</a>. Applicants have to upload their student identity card during the application process. A letter or an email will be sent to successful applicants by MTR. Applicants can then activate the "Student Status" via Octopus App or in person at an MTR customer service centre\*. Please also note that the concession for a previously approved Personalised Octopus with "Student Status" will be expired by 31 October 2023.

Hardcopy application form will also be available for students to download via MTR website starting from 1 September 2023 at <a href="http://www.mtr.com.hk/en/customer/tickets/student\_travel\_scheme.html">http://www.mtr.com.hk/en/customer/tickets/student\_travel\_scheme.html</a>. However, it is strongly recommended by MTR to use online application platform.

\*Except Airport Express stations, Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau, Racecourse, Disneyland Resort, Sunny Bay, Wong Chuk Hang, Lei Tung, South Horizons, Hin Keng, Kai Tak, Sung Wong Toi and To Kwa Wan stations.
