(#1) 2-year curriculum

(#2) **Japanese Studies:** Knowledge of Chinese characters or Japanese "Kanji" will facilitate language study in the programme. For Senior Year Entry, students are required to possess Japanese Language Proficiency Test (N2) level at the time of admission.

Music: As a reference, students should have attained a level of proficiency in their main instrument / voice at or above ABRSM / Trinity College London Grade 8 (or equivalent).

ELIGIBILITY

Local holders of an Associate Degree or a Higher Diploma;
OR Final year students of an Associate Degree or a Higher Diploma Programme

Natural Sciences: Students have to indicate the concentration areas in a priority order.

(#3) Accepts Associate Degree holders only.

(#4) Students must possess knowledge of Chinese and be fluent in Cantonese.

(#5) Subject to approval by the University.

(#6) Knowledge of Chinese required.
