

The D. H. Chen Foundation Scholarship Program offers comprehensive support to enhance the Scholars' professional knowledge, personal insights and social aspirations. A **maximum of 20 scholarships** will be awarded to undergraduate students at five local universities.

<u>Remarks</u>: On and from the date of acceptance of this Scholarship Program, Scholars are **not allowed to concurrently hold** other scholarship(s), bursaries, allowance(s) or award(s) of similar nature to the Scholarship Program, unless the components supported by the scholarship(s), bursaries, allowance(s) or award(s) in question do not overlap with those supported by the Scholarship Program and prior approval has been granted by The D. H. Chen Foundation via CUHK.

Eligibility

Applicants must fulfill ALL of the following requirements:

- Being a permanent resident of Hong Kong;
- Being a full-time Year 1 undergraduate student of a UGC-funded programme in the academic year 2023/24⁻;
- Having a Year GPA of at least 3.5 out of 4.0, or equivalent, of ALL letter grades available in 2023/24*; and
- Demonstrating leadership abilities and commitment to making positive social change.
 - ^ Students enrolled in two-year undergraduate programmes <u>or</u> students with normative study period of two academic years or shorter are **NOT** eligible for this Scholarship.
 - * Though the academic results for Term 2 of 2023/24 are not available yet at the time of application, students should still submit their scholarship application if they would like to be considered.

Application Procedures

Details of the Scholarship and its application form can be downloaded from the website of Office of Admissions and Financial Aid (OAFA) at http://admission.cuhk.edu.hk/ (Fees and Financing Your Studies → Scholarships → Open for Applications → Scholarships for Local Studies).

Applicants should read the Information Sheet, the OAFA List of Documents for Submission and all other application documents carefully and strictly follow the instructions.

Completed application form together with requisite documents should be submitted online <u>on or before</u> <u>4 June 2024</u>. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Internal Selection by University: Suitable candidates are required to attend a selection interview to be held by the University in late June / early July 2024.

The decision of the University and/or the donor is final and not subject to review, and the reasons for shortlisting, nominating, granting or refusing to offer an award will not be given.
