- (d) Documents and materials submitted with this application will not be returned.
- (e) OAFA or The Greater Bay Area Homeland Youth Community Foundation (the Foundation; the donor) may not be able to process the application if the information provided is unclear, incorrect, incomplete or without the necessary supporting document(s).
- (f) Papers and documents submitted with the Application Form should be in A4 size.
- (g) English translations must be provided if the papers and documents submitted are not in English. Submission of any papers/documents in a foreign language may not be considered.
- (h) Completed Application Forms must be returned **to your Faculty** together with the necessary supporting documents (including but not limited to Annexes A and B). Candidates should read and complete the "Checklist on Completion of Application Form" (Annex B) before submitting the Application Forms. **Any applications submitted to OAFA direct will** not be processed or considered.

 - The referee must be a person under whom the applicant has studied at CUHK, and able to give comments on the strengths and weaknesses of the applicant's academic ability, personality, qualifications, etc.
