

# McCall MacBain Scholarships (for 2026 Cohort)

The McCall MacBain Scholarships (tenable at **McGill University**, Canada) bring together a diverse group of scholars who aspire to lead with purpose – individuals who have demonstrated leadership potential and an inner drive to make a positive impact in other people's lives.

## Value of the Scholarships

Up to **30 full Scholarships** and **100 entrance awards** will be offered for **2026 admission** to **master's or professional studies** at McGill. Each full funding Scholarship covers:

- Tuition and fees for the full normal duration master's or professional program
- A living stipend of CAD\$2,300 per month during academic terms
- A one-time relocation grant for moving to Montréal
- Beginner to advanced French language courses offered through McGill
- Summer funding options

## Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for the 2026 cohort, candidates must meet ONE of the following criteria:

- Be current students on track to earn their first bachelor's degree by August 2026
- Earned their first bachelor's degree in the last five years (January 2020 or later)
- Earned their first bachelor's degree more than five years ago, and were 30 years or younger on 1 January 2025

Candidates will also need to meet the minimum degree and language requirements for McGill's program admission.

## Application Procedures

### **Application Deadline:**

- **For students and graduates of universities in Canada and the United States, as well as Canadians abroad: 24 September 2025 (4:00 pm Eastern Time)**
- **For students and graduates of universities located in other countries (e.g. CUHK): 20 August 2025 (4:00 pm Eastern Time)**

The McCall MacBain Scholarship application is separate from McGill graduate admissions. **Candidates should apply for both the scholarship and the McGill programs separately.**

2. The McCall MacBain Scholarship will forward the application materials of current students and recent graduates of CUHK to CUHK for endorsement. Therefore, these applicants are not required to seek endorsement from any CUHK's department/unit.
3. Candidates who are further shortlisted by the McCall MacBain Scholarship will be invited for interview(s) conducted by the secretariat of the McCall MacBain Scholarships from October to December 2025.
4. The decisions of CUHK and/or the secretariat of the McCall MacBain Scholarships are final and not subject to review, and the reasons for shortlisting, nominating, granting or refusing to offer an award will not be given.
