SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Carefully review the Application Guidelines and confirm your eligibility before completing this form.
2. These scholarships are **exclusively** available to **non-Chinese students of diverse ethnic backgrounds** in Hong Kong who:
 - Hold the right of abode in Hong Kong,
 - Possess a valid Hong Kong Identity Card.*(Note: Applicants holding study, travel, or visit visas are **not eligible**.)*
3. **Ho and Fung Charitable Foundation Scholarship (HK\$15,000)**
 - Open **only to first-year university students**.
 - Awarded based on outstanding academic performance.
4. **Amber Foundation Scholarship (HK\$15,000)**
 - Open to **female students in their 2nd or 3rd year of university**.
 - Aims to enhance career success through leadership development.
 - *(Awardees must participate in the **EMPOWER Program**—a series of professional leadership workshops designed to strengthen business networks and career opportunities for ethnic minority women in Hong Kong.)*
5. **Dr. Wong Kam-kuen Charity Act Scholarship for Chinese Performance (HK\$1,500)**
 - Recognizes first-year university students with exceptional performance in Chinese language in public examinations.
6. **Eligibility Criteria:**
 - Must be graduating from Form 6 in July 2025.
 - Must be enrolled in a full-time degree or sub-degree program at a Hong Kong higher education institution for the 2025/26 academic year.
7. **Application Requirements:**
 - Complete all sections of the form. If a section does not apply, write “N/A”.
 - Provide an academic reference (e.g., from a teacher).
