

Local graduates and final-year postgraduate students in any discipline are eligible to apply even though the designated programmes are education related.

Value of the Scholarship

The Scholarship will basically cover the University tuition fee at Stanford for the normative study period of the programme and an economy return airfare between Hong Kong and the US. A maintenance allowance to cover the expense of health insurance, board and lodging may be offered to the awardee if he/she has proven financial need.

Eligibility

- Candidates should be Hong Kong permanent residents.
- Candidates should be graduates of CUHK within the past ten years (i.e. Graduates of 2015 to 2024 classes), or final-year postgraduate students of CUHK in the academic year 2025/26.
- Candidates should have full-time work experience and interest in pursuit of career related to education.

- 3. The completed application form and all requisite documents should be submitted **online**, unless otherwise specified, **on or before 15 October 2025 (Hong Kong time)**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
