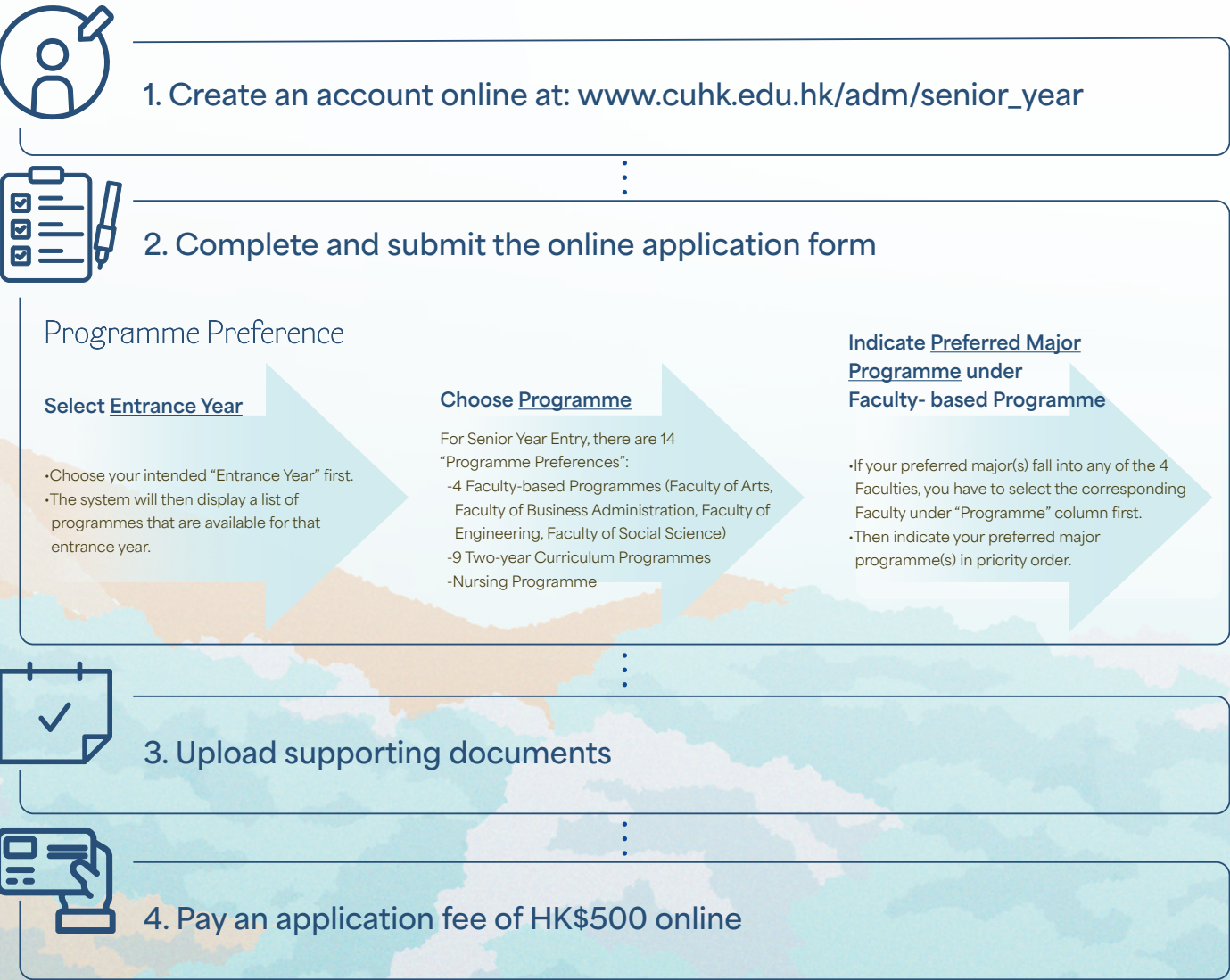

<sup>②</sup> Knowledge of Chinese characters or Japanese "Kanji" will facilitate language study in the programme. For Senior Year Entry, students are required to possess Japanese Language Proficiency Test (N2) level at the time of admission.  
<sup>③</sup> As a reference, students should have attained a level of proficiency in their main instrument / voice at or above ABRSM / Trinity College London Grade 8 (or equivalent).  
<sup>④</sup> Accepts Associate Degree holders only.  
<sup>⑤</sup> Students have to indicate the concentration areas in a priority order which include Biological Sciences, Biotechnology, Chemical and Testing Sciences, Data Science, Environmental Studies, Food and Nutrition, Physical Sciences.  
<sup>⑥</sup> Students must possess knowledge of Chinese and be fluent in Cantonese.
